

## Donation Guidelines

South Interlake Regional Library accepts donations of books, DVDs, Blu-rays and CDs. Donations will be evaluated and may be added to the collection or they may be sold in book sales. All funds raised stay with the library.

Please note that donated items in poor condition are discarded during the sorting process and that disposal of these items is time consuming. We would appreciate it if you sorted your items prior to bringing them to the library.

### We gratefully accept:

- Fiction and non-fiction books appealing to adults, young adults and children.
- Hardcover, soft-cover, trade-paperback, large-print books in any size ranging from mass-media paperback to large coffee table sized books.
- Audio books on CD.
- Harlequin Romance (no more than 5 years old).
- VHS, DVD, Blu-ray and CDs with original case.
- Magazines (no more than 5 years old).
- Antiquarian, rare and collectable books.

### We request you do not donate:

- Any items that are in poor condition.
- Burned / downloaded / recorded VHS, DVD, Blue-rays or CDs.
- Text books and Encyclopedias.
- Reader's Digest Condensed Books.
- Books or media items whose content is no longer of general interest or utility – eg. Very old medical or consumer help guides.
